A Message from Fr. Joseph Fessio, S.J.

APOLOGIA PRO LECTIONE!

OR: WHY READ AT ALL?

LEFT TO OURSELVES we are limited to what we can directly experience: sounds, sights, aromas, flavors mainly; and our memories of them. Through our senses we can know things and persons around us; but we are limited to our immediate environment of place and time. That's it.

There are, however, some ways of breaking out of our immediate surroundings. Some things that come to us through our senses are capable of taking us beyond them. Texts (books, journals, letters, blogs and Internet posts); Sounds (radio, podcasts, reports from friends and others); Images (television, films, YouTube).

All these give us what are called 'vicarious' experiences. They are 'second-hand' experiences; but without them we'd be imprisoned in our own immediate environment. Through them we can learn of anything occurring from the beginning of the world to the end—and even of what existed before all time and what will exist after all time. We can learn of anything occurring anywhere in the cosmos—and of what exists beyond the cosmos. We can literally expand our experience, albeit indirectly, infinitely.

(And we can even learn of things that don't exist at all in the primary world, but only in the minds of others: fantasy and fiction.)

We don't usually reflect formally on this amazing, breathtaking capacity—but we should, at least occasionally. Especially since nowadays, for long periods of time each day, we're not experiencing anything *other* than these vicarious experiences. We're often immersed in our devices like we are in air—and hence simply take it all for granted.


I propose being mindful about what vicarious experiences we admit through the portals of our senses.

Books are only one of these claimants for our attention. I submit they are a privileged claimant. That's hard to demonstrate in a culture that has become first, more immersed in images and second, more immersed in virtual than in physical reality. Since, in general, reading is comparatively more active than either of these, they tend to be more addictive.

Books have certainly stood the test of time. We recognize a fullness, a richness in the well-read. Books become companions; they create an attractive environment. (Compare a study lined with bookshelves to, say, a single Kindle reader or smartphone on the desk.) They are more physical: you can hold them in your hand—the thing itself, not a representation on a screen; see the whole of the book in a single glance, easily browse the pages; feel them as you read, and make marginal notations. (I know you can much of this with a digital book, but it's somehow not the same—maybe like a plastic dining room table compared to an oak one.)

Of course there are bad books: some are bad art; some are morally bad; and most tend to be both. But there are thousands, likely hundreds of thousands of good books, and many can be classified as great books. Certainly more than anyone can read in a lifetime.

So . . . break out of your solitude. Expand your horizons. Enrich your lives and the lives of those around you. Read good books! (And you can check out this catalogue for some good suggestions.)



In *Introducing Communion Theology*, Tracey Rowland offers an accessible yet profound exploration of this influential theological



PIERBATTISTA CARDINAL PIZZABALLA, O.F.M., has lived, studied, and worked in the Holy Land since 1990, first as a student of Scripture, then as the custodian of the Holy Land, and finally as the Latin patriarch of Jerusalem.

He describes himself as “part radical and part museum curator—a radical in preaching and living the Gospel, but a protector of the Christian memory, faith, heritage and story that weave us into one believing people over the centuries”.

But he is more. Cardinal Pizzaballa has led his flock hopefully and unflinchingly through the horrors of war, offering his own life during the hostage situation of October 7, 2023, and calling constantly for an end to hostilities. Through years of darkness, he has spurred the persecuted Christians of the Holy Land to “a vibrant testimony of faith and belonging”.

Imbued with the spirit of Saint Francis, this beautiful work includes many talks from Pizzaballa’s years as custos and apostolic administrator of Jerusalem, as well as a robust appendix of material from his time as patriarch. “As the Apostle Paul spoke about the breadth and length and height and depth of God’s love (Ephesians 3:18),” explains scholar Jeff Cavins, “so Cardinal Pizzaballa speaks of the breadth and length and height and depth of the Holy Land.”

Is there hope for peace in Jerusalem, indeed, the world? Yes—through Christ alone. *The Heart of All Nations* calls Christians not only to experience Jesus’ radical peace in their hearts, but to bear it courageously into a turbulent age.




Diary of a Young Missionary **E**




diary that gives it a sense of “immediacy” that makes it stand out from the more conventional memoir genre.






St. John Henry Newman


IN 1974 FR. JOSEPH FESSIO, S.J. returned to the United States from then-West Germany, where he had completed his doctoral studies in theology under Professor Joseph Ratzinger (who would later become Pope Benedict XVI). Previously Fr. Fessio had been pursuing graduate studies in theology in France, mentored by Fr. Henri de Lubac, S.J. It was Fr. de Lubac who proposed to Father Fessio that he write his doctoral thesis on the theology of Fr. Hans Urs von Balthasar, and who wrote to Professor Ratzinger asking that Fr. Fessio be accepted by him as a doctoral student.

De Lubac, Balthasar, and Ratzinger—along with Fr. Louis Bouyer—were among the most distinguished Catholic theologians of the 20th century, but in the 1970s, few of their works were known in the United States and even fewer were available in English translation. It was to serve the good of the Catholic Church by making these works available to English-speaking readers, that in June of 1978, Fr. Fessio, along with Carolyn Lemon, began Ignatius Press.
