When a near-universal chorus of politicians, medical professionals, and Catholic clergy megaphoned the command to “isolate,” Kevin couldn't imagine a more dooming word for his family, his marriage, and the life of his wife.

Yet God had other plans. Wells' honest tale of inner crisis and hope-filled resurrection takes readers on a spiritual rollercoaster, offering a penetrating exploration of the sacramental grace of marriage and the mysterious movement of God in dry, lonely places.

In the journey from darkness to light, three lives—Krista, Kevin, and Father Flum—became forever entwined. It is a deeper kind of love story. The chapters on the fits and starts of renewal unfold like the piecemeal opening of a tomb. *The Hermit* is a true account of marital survival, a holy priest, redemption, and even the miraculous, where imprisoned shame

and sin are transformed into the joy of freedom.

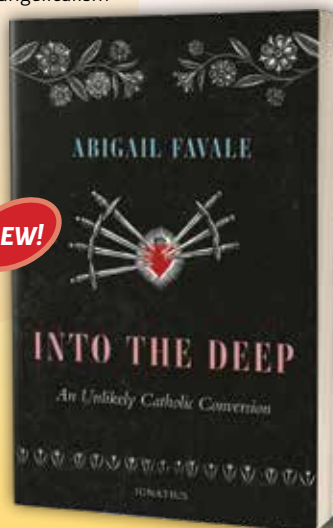

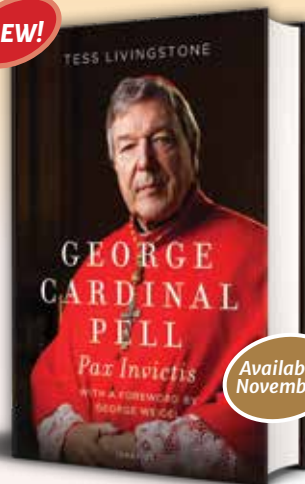

George Cardinal Pell: Pax Invictus A Biography **E**

Tess Livingstone

Among Cardinal George Pell's heroes were St John Fisher, Cardinal Joseph Mindszenty, and Cardinal Nguyen Van Thuan. On February 27, 2019, Cardinal Pell joined their ranks as an unjustly imprisoned prince of the Church. After 404 days in solitary confinement for crimes he didn't commit, Australia's highest court unanimously overturned his conviction. This definitive biography traces Pell's life from childhood in regional Australia to the Vatican Treasurer in 2014, through his trials, imprisonment, and rebuilding his life.

Richly endowed with intellectual and sporting talent, and faith in Christ, the young George Pell turned down a professional



football contract and instead entered the seminary. After his ordination in 1966 and completing a doctorate at Oxford, he served as a country curate, a Catholic university leader, seminary rector, as Archbishop of Melbourne and Sydney and then in Rome.

Like many bishops of his generation, Pell found dealing with the evil of clerical sex abuse a herculean challenge. In his role as Vatican Treasurer, his battles to reform corrupt, sclerotic financial systems drew hostility from an entrenched “old guard”.

“George Pell, go to hell!” detractors bellowed the night he was installed as Archbishop of Sydney, outside his court trial, and outside St Mary's Cathedral during his funeral on Candlemas Day, 2023. Many more grieved the sudden loss of a cherished friend, father figure, and courageous leader whose belief in Christ saw him live out his episcopal motto “Be Not Afraid” to the full.

This in-depth, page-turning biography of Father Joseph Fessio, S.J., founder of Ignatius Press and the University of San Francisco's Saint Ignatius Institute, is written by one of Fessio's earliest Jesuit mentors, historian Father Cornelius Buckley, S.J.

Born and raised in the San Francisco Bay Area during the golden age after World War II, the bold, often reckless Joe Fessio would suddenly enter the Society of Jesus at age twenty and, by divine providence, find himself studying under three of the greatest theological minds of the twentieth century—Henri de Lubac, Hans Urs von Balthasar, and Joseph Ratzinger (Pope Benedict XVI).



Over the decades, he would transform into one of the most powerful and energetic forces in the American Catholic Church, designing a pioneering Catholic Great Books program at USF and founding perhaps the largest Catholic publishing house in the English-speaking world.

With many hysterical glimpses into the engine rooms of Catholic institutions,

Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen *Convert Maker* **E**

This book examines the life, priesthood, and celebrity of Venerable Fulton J. Sheen in the tumultuous 20th century, as well as unfolding the process of conversion for eight of his most noteworthy and sometimes controversial converts—Ada Smith, Heywood Broun, Louis Boudenz, Clare Boothe Luce, Elizabeth Bentley, Fritz Kreisler, Bella Dodd, and Virginia Mayo.

This work opens the world of mid-20th century America that made Bishop Fulton Sheen a celebrity, first on radio and then as an Emmy award-winning television personality. His was one of the most recognizable faces in the country who used his popularity to bring many lost sheep into the Catholic Church. Communists, movie stars, writers and countless others made their way to his door for instructions in



the faith, and some of their fascinating convert stories are intertwined here with Sheen’s biography.

Sheen firmly believed that the Church needed to be poor to serve the poor. He personally donated to the missions and to the poor all the money he ever earned, over \$200,000,000. Bishop Sheen was also an active participant at the Second Vatican Council where he befriended the Bishop of Kraków, Karol Wojtyła, the future Pope John Paul II.

Fulton Sheen was above all a devout Catholic priest deeply devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary and to Jesus Christ, especially in the Holy Eucharist, making a Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament every day. He influenced countless conversions to Catholicism, but was always clear that it was the Holy Spirit, not Sheen, who makes the convert. **Illustrated with photos.**

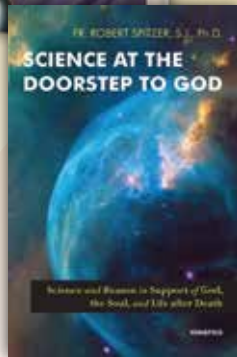

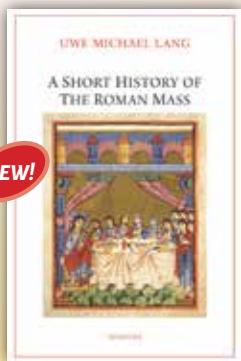

The Roman Rite is the most widely used among the liturgical rites of the Catholic Church. This book is a short introduction to the development of the Roman Rite of Mass from its origins in early Christianity until the present day.

Ever since the liturgical reforms that were initiated by Pope Pius XII in the mid-20th century, fully embraced by the Second Vatican Council and implemented in the post-conciliar period, there has been an intense and often controversial debate on continuity and rupture in liturgical development. When this question is discussed, the long and complex history of the Roman liturgy is not always sufficiently recognized. The trajectory of this book shows both continuity and change.

The work challenges the conventional narrative that the liturgy of the Western Church moved from early dynamic development through medieval decline to early modern stagnation and was only revived in the wake of Vatican II—a narrative that still has considerable traction both in academic publications and in a wider public.

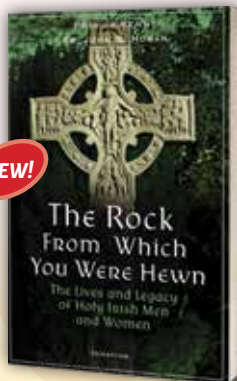

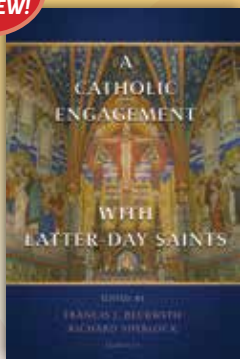

A collection of Catholic scholars address several theological topics over which Mormons and Catholics hold contrary beliefs: the

great apostasy, the papacy, the Eucharist, the Trinity, the incarnation, the nature of God, justification, sainthood, liturgy, and deification. The contributors, some of whom are converts to Catholicism from Mormonism, offer a respectful, though critical, analysis of LDS beliefs.

The Catholic Church has focused virtually all of its ecumenical efforts on the ecclesial communities that arose from the Reformation, the Orthodox Churches, and Judaism. Left out of these discussions has been the Mormon Church, even though it has grown to nearly 16 million members internationally by 2016 from its modest beginnings in 1830.

This work examines the LDS faith as an important and serious challenge to the Catholic narrative of the origin and development of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Absent the ad hominem attacks and lurid historical details that are often found in popular Christian assessments of the LDS Church, this book is intended by its editors to lead to further dialogue and better understanding.

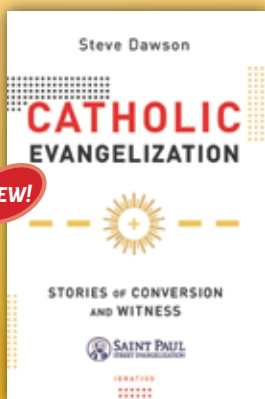

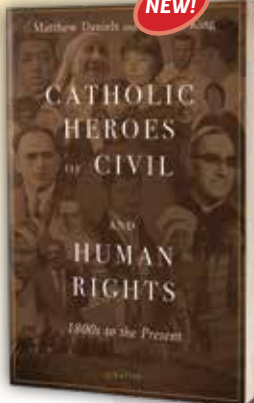

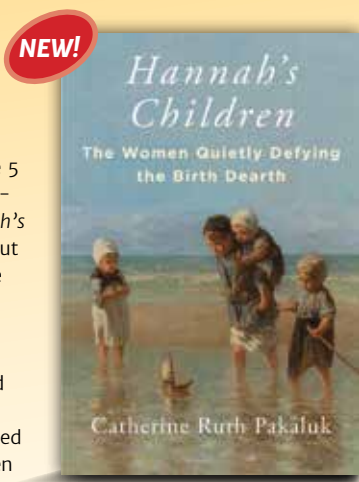

In the midst of a historic “birth dearth,” why do some 5 percent of American women choose to defy the demographic norm by bearing five or more children? *Hannah's Children* is a compelling portrait of these overlooked but fascinating mothers who, like the biblical Hannah, see their children as their purpose, their contribution, and their greatest blessing.

The social scientist Catherine Pakaluk, herself the mother of eight, traveled across the United States and interviewed fifty-five college-educated women who were raising five or more children. Through open-ended questions, she sought to understand who these women are, why and when they chose to have a large family, and what this choice means for them, their families, and the nation.

Hannah's Children is more than interesting stories of extraordinary women. It presents information that is urgently relevant for the future of American prosperity. Many countries have experimented with aggressively pro-natalist public policies, and all of them have failed. Pakaluk finds that the quantitative methods to which the social sciences limit themselves overlook important questions of meaning and identity in their inquiries into fertility rates. Her book is a pathbreaking foray into questions of purpose, religion, transcendence, healing, and growth—questions that ought to inform economic inquiry in the future.
