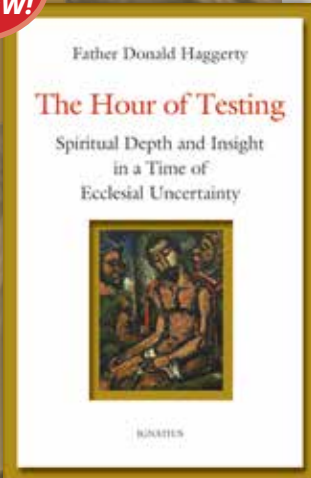

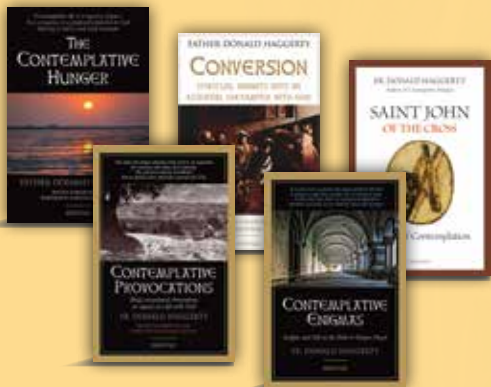

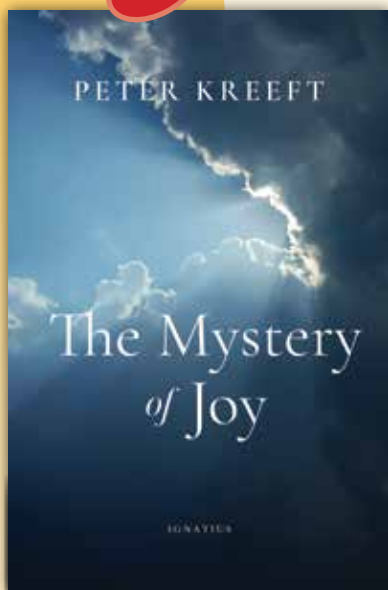
The Mystery of Joy

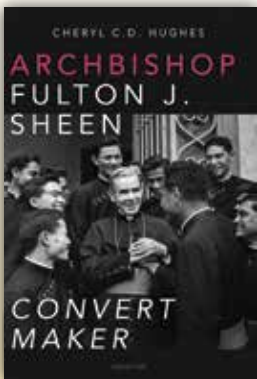
Venerable Fulton J. Sheen was one of the greatest spiritual leaders—and entertainers—in the twentieth century. His television

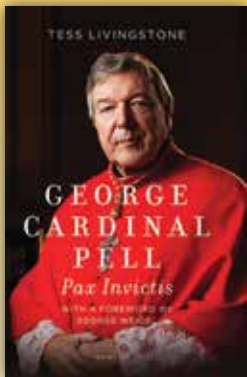

Richly endowed with intellectual and athletic talent, the young George Pell turned down a



professional football contract and instead entered the seminary in 1960. After his ordination in 1966, he served as a country curate, a Catholic university leader, a

seminary rector, the archbishop of Melbourne, and the archbishop of Sydney. Made a cardinal by Pope John Paul II in 2003, he was chosen by Pope Francis as the prefect for the new Secretariat for the Economy in 2014.

After being falsely accused of clerical sex abuse, he suffered 404 days in solitary confinement for a crime he did not commit. In his role as Vatican treasurer, his efforts to reform the Church's finances met with resistance from an entrenched “old guard”. Through it all, he retained his dignity and integrity as a faithful successor to the apostles.

Carlo Acutis was like other boys his age. In his hometown of Milan, Italy, he loved video games, playing soccer, and hanging out with his friends.
