A Message from Fr. Joseph Fessio, S.J.

TOO MANY THINGS HAPPENING!

In the country, in the world, and at Ignatius Press, too.

There are so many current events making claims on our attention (and how many of you have to fight off, as I do, an addiction to news?) it's hard to make time for "the permanent things" that are nourished by prayer, study, and serious reading.

While it's hard to "make time" for such worthwhile pursuits, it's nevertheless possible to "find time": e.g., while commuting, exercising, or doing housework.

To help you do this, Ignatius Press has upped its podcasting production. We've upgraded our audio and video equipment, begun interviewing major figures like Peter Kreeft and Amy Welborn, created video shorts from previous episodes, and started a new feature, "Ignatius Press – Off the Shelf", a book club hosted by Joseph Pearce, Vivian Dudro, and myself.

I myself prefer books. (I don't have much of a commute where I could listen to podcasts. It's 35 feet from where I sleep to the chapel, and one flight up and another 80 feet to my office. Even "shorts" won't do.) And Ignatius Press has plenty of those, too. Among our new titles:

- A new translation of Bernanos' classic *Diary of a Country Priest*. Did you know that entire pages of the original French text are missing in the translation that's been in use since 1937? That, according to the new translator, "the Curé of Ambricourt's last utterance is an unattributed quotation of [St. Thérèse's] own words as she lay dying: '*Tout est grâce*' ('All is grace'). Morris' mistranslation of this vital phrase ('Grace is everywhere') undermines the novel's entire theological and spiritual foundation."
- Michael O'Brien's latest novel, *Letter to the Future*, a post-apocalyptic (Read it to find out what that is!) tale set in the future, looking back on our present time.
- And then something many of us have been waiting a long time for. We finally prevailed upon a persistently demurring Peter Kreeft to write his autobiography. Be inspired by the fascinating life of this prolific Catholic teacher and author. He's written over 90 books, more than one for each year of his long life. This one won't disappoint.



From Calvinist to Catholic **E**

Peter Kreeft

WITH OVER one hundred books to his name, Peter Kreeft is the most prolific Catholic author of his generation. He's also one of the most loved, having influenced countless Catholics in the U.S. and beyond. But who, exactly, is the man behind the books? In this new autobiography, Kreeft finally lets readers into his own story, including the encounters, people, and ideas that led him to the Catholic Church as a young man.

With his signature insight and sharp wit, Kreeft takes readers through his childhood in midcentury New Jersey, where his family attended a Dutch Reformed church and anti-Catholicism was a given, to his undergraduate years at Calvin College, where he studied philosophy and found himself on the road to Rome. From there, we follow him to Fordham and Yale, where he finally swam the Tiber in 1960—with his future wife, Maria, as godmother. Finally, he reflects on his post conversion years, distilling

Should we not, in our reforms, keep our eyes fixed constantly on Mary . . . so that we ourselves might know what the Church, the ecclesial spirit, ecclesial conduct really are?”

Echoing Balthasar, *Word, Sacrament, Charism* looks to Mary, not the

world, for the way forward.

**Remembering George Cardinal Pell** **E***Recollections of a Great Man of the Church***Edited by Tracey Rowland**

CARDINAL GEORGE PELL was a significant figure in Australian public life and in the life of the Catholic Church from the time of his appointment to the episcopacy in the 1980s until his death in 2023. His imprisonment for some 404 days for a crime he did not commit was one of the greatest miscarriages of justice in Australian legal history. His scape-goat treatment has been compared to that of Alfred Dreyfus in the period of the Third French Republic.

As a defender of Catholic orthodoxy Pell drew opposition from liberal Catholic quarters and from anti-Christian intellectual elites, and as the Vatican's Prefect for the Economy, he found himself in the position of having to expose and then clean up the financial corruption within the Roman Curia. Thus he was fighting wars on more than one front in more than one country. He had many enemies but he also had many friends and was revered by young Catholics on the orthodox end of the theological spectrum.

This book is a collection of memoirs by those who knew him well. It is not intended


as an exercise in hagiography or apologetics, but rather it reveals dimensions of the Cardinal's personality that never made the pages of the popular press.

This book is a record of memories those who knew Cardinal Pell as a gift to future generations of Catholics who may find this era of history of interest. In particular, it is record for younger Catholics who come from families where their parents and grandparents supported the Cardinal. Since the Cardinal was well known, not only in Australia, but across the entire Anglosphere, this collection of memoirs should be of broad, international interest. In the manner of a kaleidoscope, it offers

a multidimensional picture of a man who, love him or loathe him, was a passionate defender of the Catholic faith.
